

# SCANS



BULL SNORT: Looking for ENORMOUS VOLUME with upside price action.

Volume=Price, Cause=Effect

**GAPPERS:** Large upside gap ups that remain unfilled.

Big Gap Ups = Street Caught Off Guard

**STRENGTH:** Green/positive names on down days.

Looking for relative strength.

**DOUBLERS:** Stocks that double are more likely to double again.

52 WEEK HIGHS: Track stocks making new highs to understand what sectors are in favor and to uncover new ideas.

YOU HAVE TO LOVE THE ROUTINE

**% GAINERS:** Look for the top performing names on a day.

### TOOLS



- 1. FINVIZ: Create a free account and save your screens.There is a premium version that people use but I have never used it.
- 2. MARKETSMITH: The top tool out there. Around \$100 per month. I am trying to learn the product better but do not know it all that well.
- 3. TRADING SOFTWARE: Each software has scanning abilities.






- NOT ALL GAPS FILL. UNFILLED GAPS=STRENGTH.
- BREAKAWAY GAPS CAN BE A PRE-CURSOR TO AN EXTENDED MOVE TO THE UPSIDE.
- EARNINGS, FDA APPROVAL, PRE-ANNOUNCEMENT...
  ANYTHING THAT CAUSES A "SURPRISE"
- OFTEN ACCOMPANIED BY HUGE VOLUME (BULL SNORT) AND BEST WHEN OUT OF A BIG BASE

# SPOTTING RELATIVE STRENGTH


- LOOK FOR NAMES THAT MAKE HIGHER LOWS AS THE INDEX MAKES LOWER LOWS
- IS A STOCK MAKING A NEW HIGH AS THE INDEX CORRECTS? PAY ATTENTION!!



CORRECTIONS ARE GREAT AS LONG AS YOU DON'T RIDE THEM DOWN








- Mar 09, 2020 NASDAQ makes a new low and so does LVGO
- Mar 12, 2020 NASDAQ makes a new low and so does LVGO (barely). The index is 7% lower as LVGO is about even.
- Mar 16, 2020 NASDAQ makes another new low and LVGO does too. The selling pressure is too much.
- Mar 18, 2020 NASDAQ ticks a new low BUT LVGO makes a HIGHER LOW!! Antenna should perk up. What is going on here?
- Mar 23, 2020 NASDAQ scums another new low. LVGO makes a SECOND HIGHER LOW!
  - This is a positive divergence. The stock is likely being bought by institutions into the index correction.

RELATIVE STRENGTH IS A SPRINGBOARD FOR HIGHER PRICES



# MY LISTS



IPO LIST: Pay attention to names that IPO. Add any interesting names to this list. Often big winners breakout and start their advance in the 6-18 month age range.

BULL SNORTS: Build lists every quarter of stocks that have positive reactions on their respective earnings reports.

INSTITUTIONAL LEADERS: Liquid name brand stocks. (AAPL MSFT SQ PTON ROKU)

DAILY LIST: Filled with names from monthly A to Z scan. Review this for weekly/daily setups.

**FOCUS LIST:** What names do I think are actionable today?

FINE TUNE YOUR LISTS
TO NARROW IN ON
THE BEST NAMES

TOP DOGS: Maximum of ten names. What are the absolute best names in the market? This is where we want our capital.

MARKETSMITH: REPORTS, STOCKS, TECHNICAL, TOP 150 EPS, TOP 150 RS, ACCUMULATION DISTRIBUTION RATING

# TOP DOG



WHAT'S BEST IN BREED?

**RELATIVE STRENGTH:** The stock should be outperforming the market.

BIG EARLY STAGE BASE: Stocks breaking out of Stage 1 Bases have more runway.

BIG VOLUME: Volume is a sign of institutional demand.

**BIG THEME:** Is this disruptive? Does it make sense? Is it complicated or simple?

SALES GROWTH: #1 fundamental criteria for me. Companies that can generate enormous sales growth are expanding and taking market share.

**EARNINGS GROWTH:** Over time earnings drive stock prices higher over time.

HIGH BETA AND LIQUID: Names that move more than the indexes but are also liquid and give you the ability to get in and out with less slippage.

Find balance here.

Low Floats = Fast Moves (in both directions)

**HIGHER PRICED:** Above \$10-\$15 at a minimum for me.

Nothing against penny stocks....they can clearly work huge. They also have higher risk and less institutional sponsorship.

### **Saturday Morning**

- 1. Review Russell 3000 or whatever list works best for you.
- 2. Review Liquid Institutional Leaders List
- 3. Go through Growth 250 on MarketSmith Cell Phone App
- 4. Get list of 30-40 good looking names for the week

### **Sunday Night**

- 5. Grill Top Dogs List to make sure focused on the right things
- 6. Update Daily List which I will review throughout the week.
- 7. Have Focus List for next day ready
- 8. Have plan set for all open positions

# DAILY ROUTINE

YOU HAVE TO LOVE THE ROUTINE

### 7:00AM

Check phone app, have breakfast, play with kid for an hour.

### 9:00AM

Mental Rehearsal

### After The Open

Write down alerts that go off on a notepad to look back at later.

After the morning rush, look at the liquid institutional leaders list, key names just to see how everything is trading overall.

### 8:00AM

Look for any news events.

### 9:30AM

Trade the open. Sort my positions by % gain right after the open.

### ••••• After The Close

End of day review gappers, bull snort, 52-week highs.

Run through all my lists, set alerts, create a new focus list for the next day, and do it all over again.
